Hi,

I am actually not sure which plastic housing you mean for the fuel lines, but if the O-rings match up then it is perfectly fine to use a little bit of oil to lubricate them.

The intake manifold gaskets go on clean and dry – a small dab of RTV should be used at each of the 4 spots where the intake manifold gaskets and end seals meet.

New intake manifold bolts are recommended, and Fel-Pro applies any required sealers or compounds to bolts. The intake bolt set ES 72224 is no exception, the bolts have pre-applied sealer, so you don't need to worry about using any and they do not need to be retorqued.

We hope this helps!
